  - Alternate deployment by national dealers with their own ACS
    - No support in CWMP for multiple ACS or service-specific ACS
    - Devices would need to be pre-configured/provisioned before going to customer
  - Q: Do we need to add IDS elements?
    - A: Yes, to the extent that they are in the SM
  - Q: Will CWMP offer a remediation mechanism for IDS?
    - A: Yes via firmware, application, and settings changes
    - There are operations to perform diagnostics, etc.
  - Start working on policy/access control based on IETF work?
