Introduction

- The intent of the Cloud Imaging Model Working Group is to develop a model for providing Imaging Services via a Cloud Imaging System in a way consistent with the PWG Semantic Model.
- The current PWG Cloud Imaging Model contends that the operations interface between a User Client and a Cloud Imaging Service is no different than that between a User Client and any networked Imaging Service, with the exception of asynchronous notification capability (if any).
- However, Cloud Imaging Services often must interface with out-of-cloud end devices (e.g., printers, scanners) to which direct access is blocked by a firewall. The PWG Model identifies a Local Imaging System Proxy intermediate agent and defines a new set of operations from Proxy to Cloud Service.

Recent Changes to Model Specification

Added:

- GetProxiedServices and GetProxiedServiceElements to Cloud Service Management operations
- GetProxiedSystems and GetProxiedSystemElements to Cloud System Management operations
- GetServiceNotifications to Cloud System Control Service as well as Imaging Service(s) in transaction diagrams

Eliminated:

- GetCloudTerminatedJobs request in favor of automatic return of this information in response to UpdateActiveJobs
- Clarified various descriptions
- Updated Sequence Diagrams
- Corrected elements listed in Operations Tables
- Added Elements list in appendix

Questions to be Considered

- Are Operations to include Service Type in Name?
 (e.g., AcknowledgePrintJob, generalized to Acknowledge<service>Job).
 - Service UUID is included as element in all Proxy operations.
 - Semantic Model Schema includes Service Name in all operations.
 - MFD Model Specification (SM2) uses < service > term in all operation names.
 - How handled in SM3 yet to be determined.
- How do we call Cloud Services versus proxied Services?
 - Cloud Model currently considers that Local Imaging System Proxy communicates with "Cloud Service" (using defined proxy operations) and with "Local Service" (using undefined operations, but possibly standard SM-defined networked client-service operations).
 - Semantic Model appears to prefer "SourceService" (probably for Cloud Service) and Destination Service (for Local or Proxied Service).
 - But although the Cloud or Source Service may consistently be the immediate Source of a Job, it is neither the ultimate source of the Job nor necessarily the source of data, including document data.
 - The Local or Destination service may not be local to User or even to the Proxy, but it is not in the Cloud.

- Submit to PWG vote.
- SM3 WG Interface
 - Request that new Cloud-oriented Operations be added to SM 3 and existing operations adjusted to reflect Cloud Model versions.
 - Request Cloud Services to be Modeled?
