# Overview

---



- Cloud-based applications and solutions are increasingly common.
- Cloud-based imaging (printing/scanning/etc.) is emerging in several different forms.
- A series of BOF meetings focused on modeling and understanding the use cases, requirements, and existing implementations were held.
- We formed the Cloud Imaging Working Group at the February 2011 PWG F2F meeting in Hawaii.
- The charter for the working group is now through PWG Formal Vote and approved by the Steering Committee.

# Overview (continued)

---

- The Cloud Imaging WG focus is around providing a set of specifications to support Cloud-based printing, scanning, and facsimile (collectively called “Cloud Imaging”).
- Work will be split into two phases. The first phase will focus around Print, the second phase the rest of the functionality will be rolled in.
- Phase 1 consists of three documents:
  - Cloud Imaging Model and Requirements
  - Cloud Print Internet Printing Protocol Binding
  - Cloud Print SOAP Binding
