IPP Specification change proposed by Harry Lewis:

Ron explained the reason for the change was to prevent a permanent IPP specification of the three printer classes based upon the referenced common industry labels (i.e. Workgroup, Enterprise, and Production). The only link from IPP to the defined groups should be the versions 2.0, 2.1, and 2.2.

There was no disagreement and the change will be accepted and incorporated in the next update of the specification.

Other Specification changes:

1. Removal of section 6.3 (Required Document Formats). After a short discussion it was agreed to remove this section. For CUPS or Apple applications this could be specified within their documentation.
2. Need text for section 7 (IANA and PWG Considerations). There are no IANA or PWG registrations required. It was suggested that Ira may have some standard text to be included here. Ron will contact Ira for input.
3. Need text for Section 9 (Security Considerations). Ron will work with Ira on this item.
4. New Attributes Required section. Mike Sweet will try to compile a complete list of attributes prior to the next teleconference.
