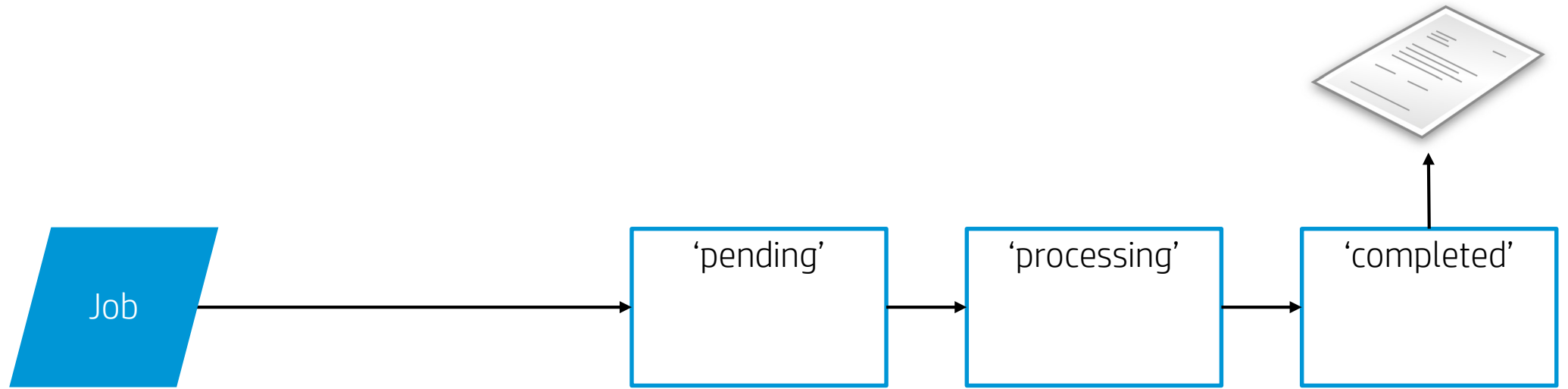


# Feature Compatibility

- IPP Enterprise Printing Extensions v2.0 defines several “conceptual features”
  - Job Release
  - Job Storage
  - Proof Print
- These conceptual features each affect how a Job becomes a candidate for processing and what happens to that Job when its processing is finished.
- Interoperability between these features needs to be considered carefully to ensure their orthogonality to one another

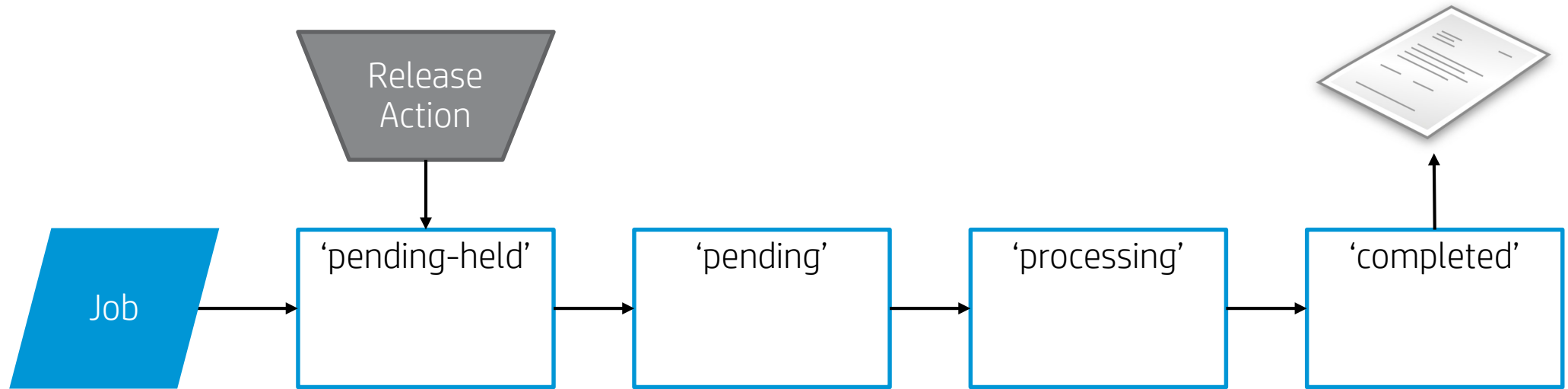

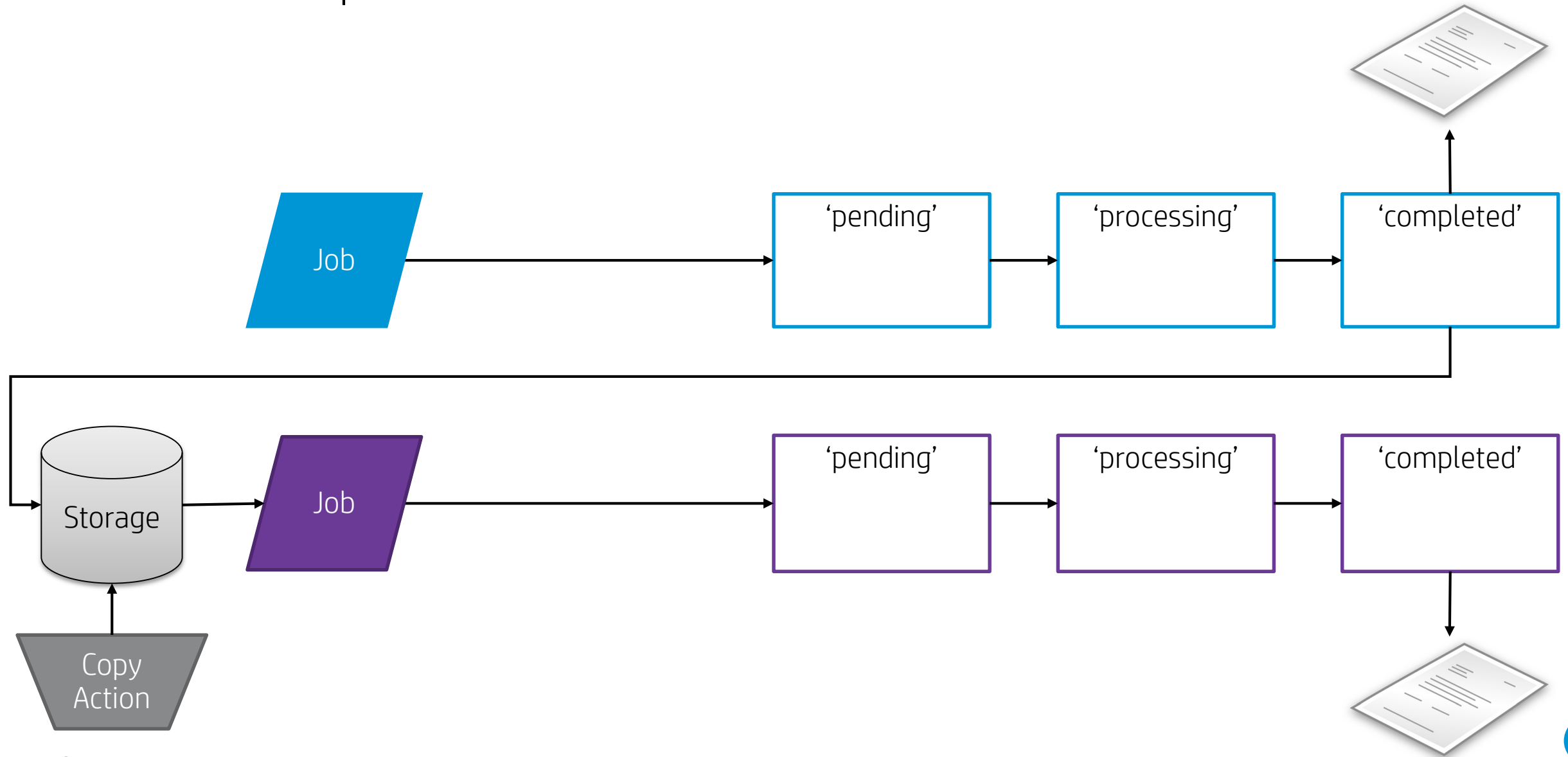

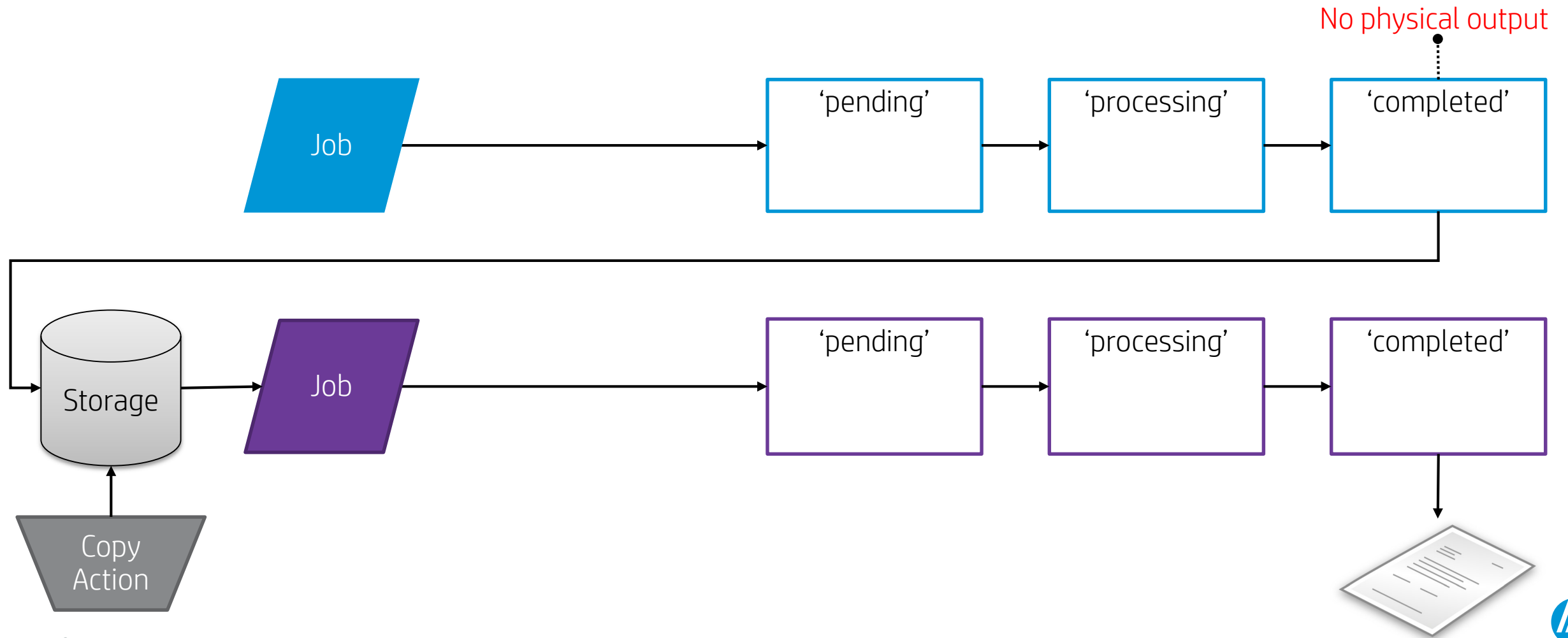

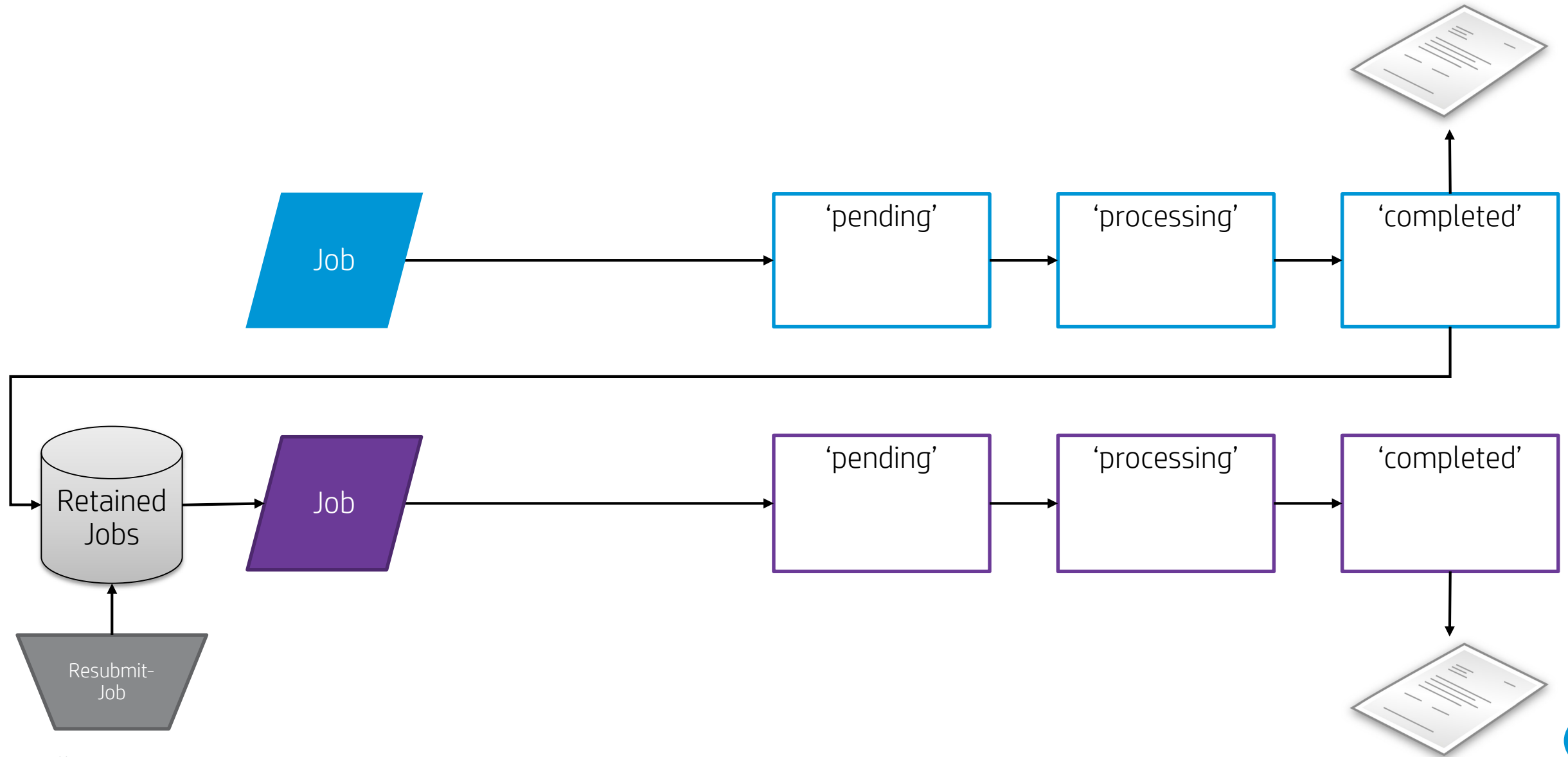

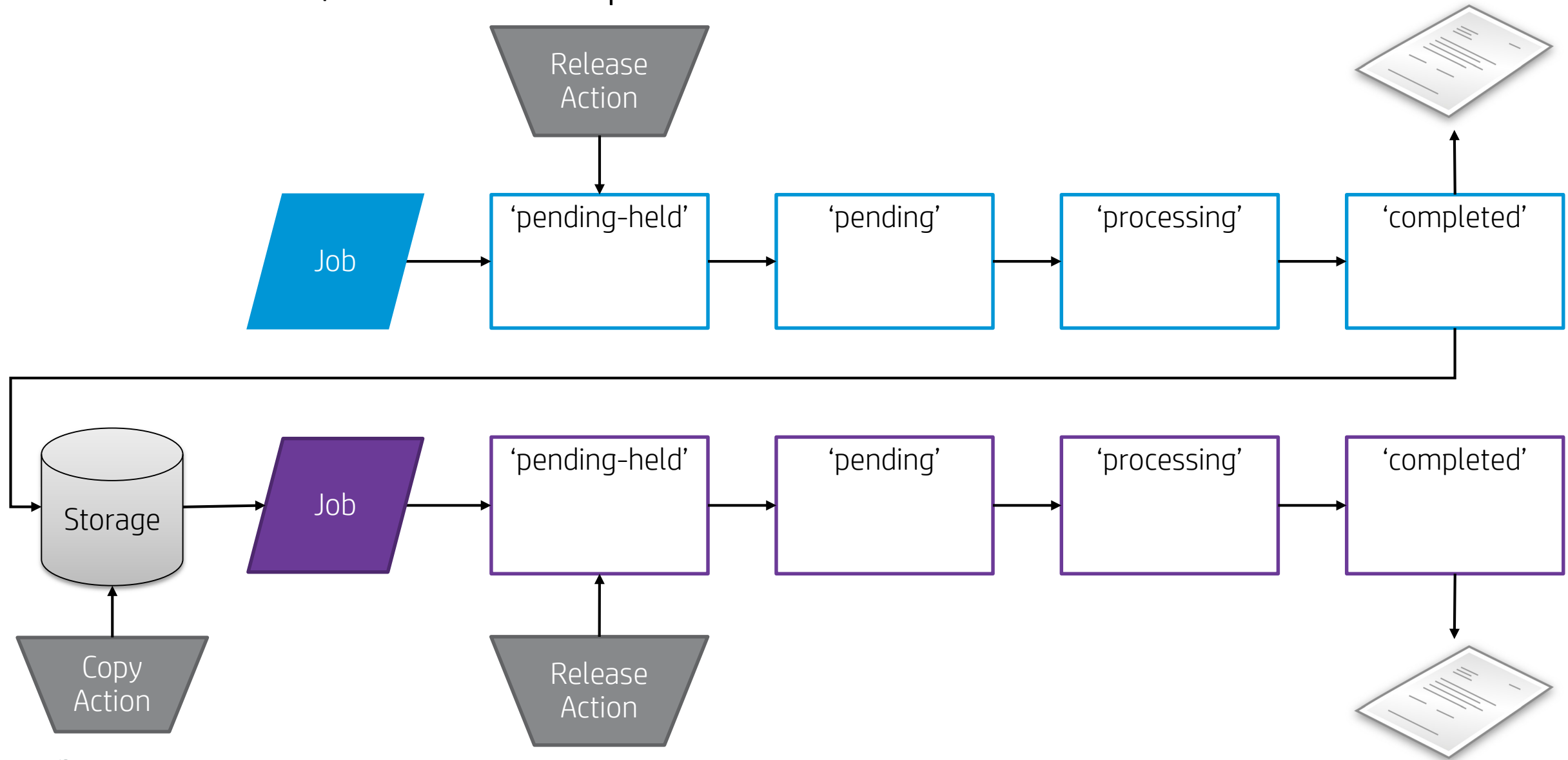

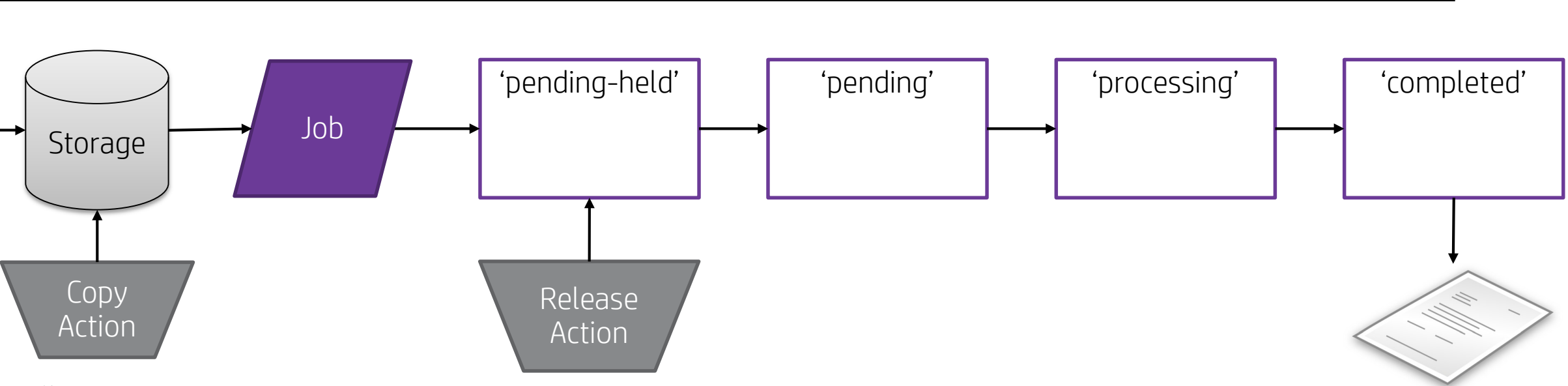

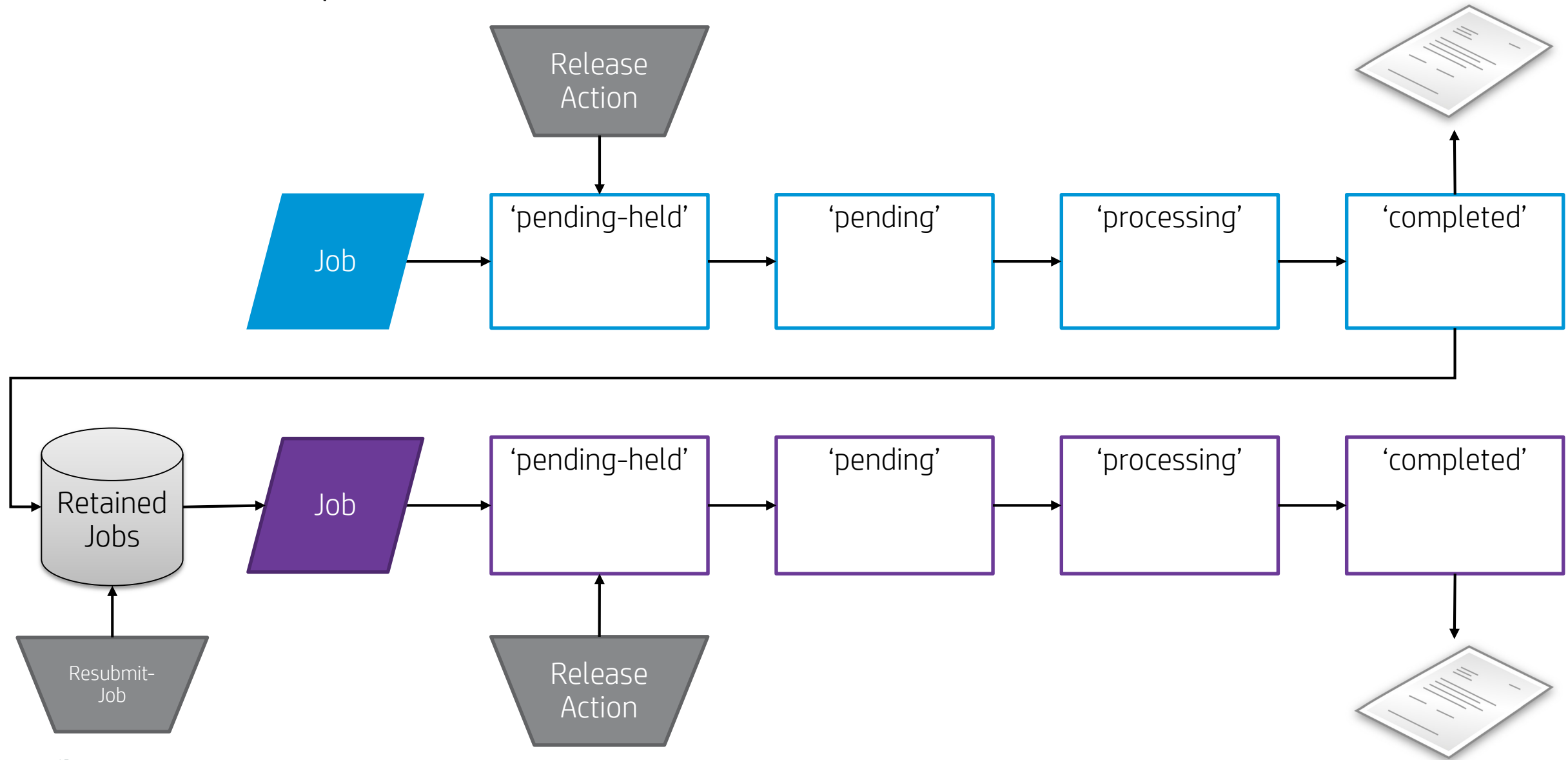

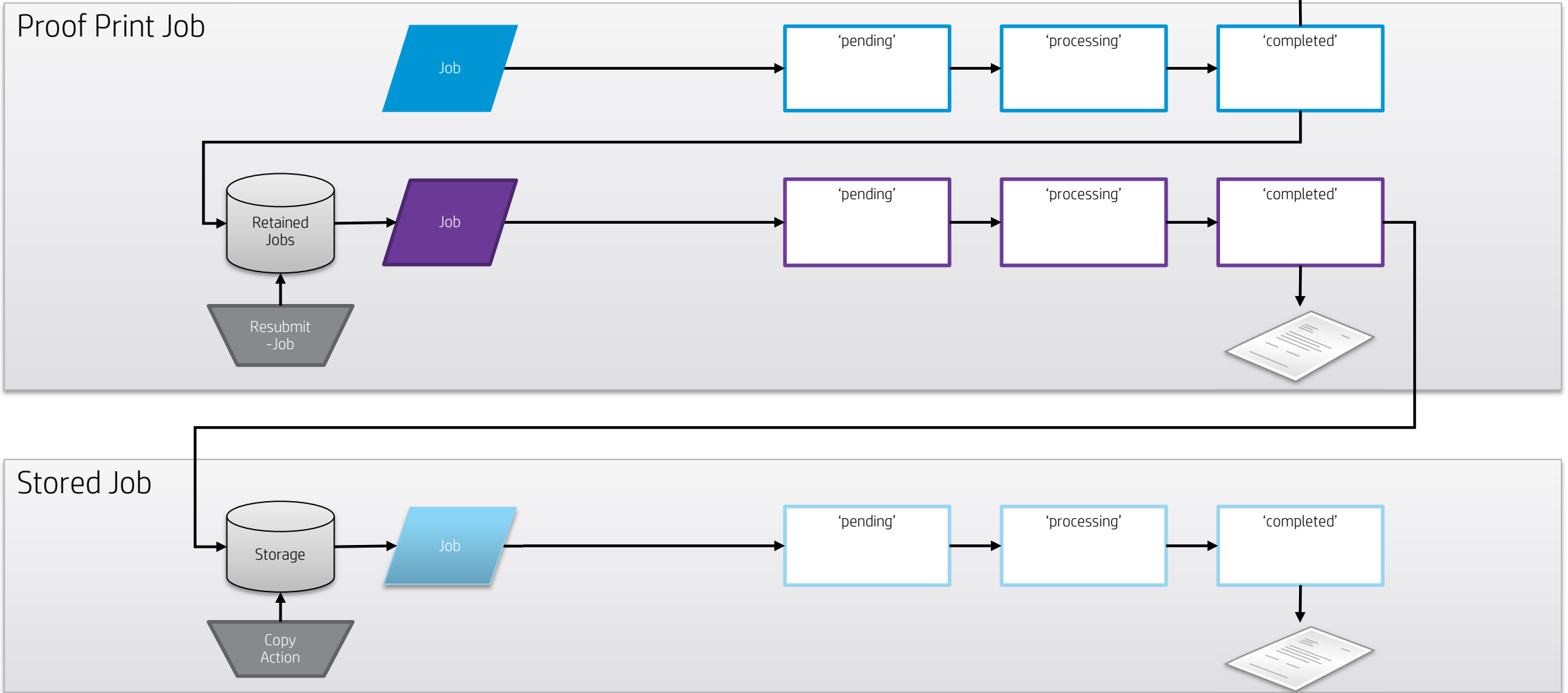


# Release Job / Proof Print Job



# Proof Print Job / Stored Job 'print-and-store'

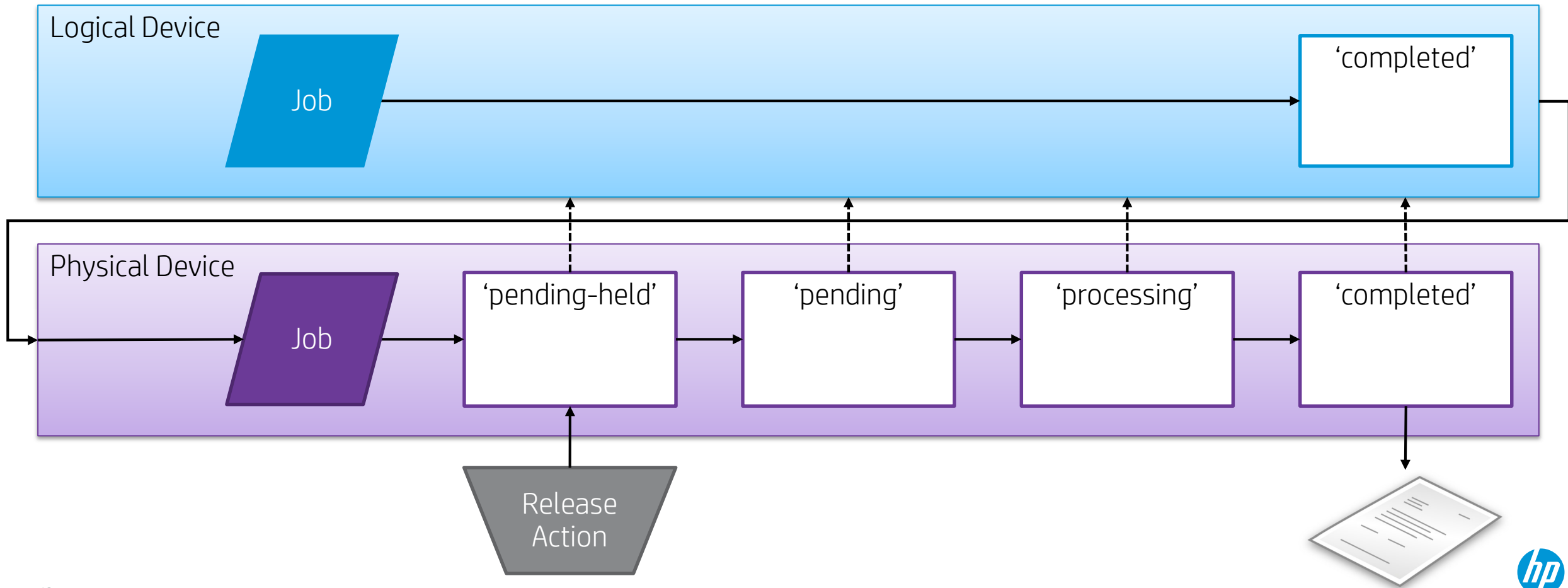
The 'store-only' option is incompatible with "proof-print"
