### **6. Status of Scan Service Vote**

### **7. Discuss the overall MFD document.**

- There was a question on how the platen and marker maximum sizes are represented.
  - i. The platen is represented by an instance of the ScanMediaPath element with the appropriate type set.
  - ii. The marker is a bit more difficult since we are stuck with the current standards representation. The standards represent the size of the media that can be moved through the device and not the size of the marker or imager. Often the size of the bypass media path is the maximum size of the marker
  - iii. Addressability does not represent size it represents resolution
  - iv. Margins do not represent size. They place a constraint on the area that can be marked. The constraint is relative to the size of the media being marked.
  
- Agreed that for generalization in figures 6 and 7 Scan Region should be called Content Region for all image acquisition services (e.g. Scan, Copy)

**AI:** Bill Wagner will add make the changes to the specification.

- Updates to the specification will be made for Job Ticket life cycle to make it generic.

**AI:** Peter Zehler will make the change to the text and figure 9

- XMLSPY figures in the specification are missing

**AI:** Peter Zehler will generate the figures

- It was noted that Restart operation **MUST** be attempted gracefully.
- It was agreed that support of the Restart operation does not require support of the Startup or Shutdown operations.
- Need to be consistent in “list of keywords” type (i.e. plural) and boolean type (i.e. lowercase).
