General Discussion

- Minutes from January 19th face-to-face / teleconference were accepted.
- Ira has found issues with the documents he originally posted. Ira suggested the documents be reviewed for typos. Clauses (descriptions and mapping strings), and model correspondences have been cleaned up by Ira.
- Capabilities (“big” enumeration of processing and finishing attributes in Printer Class) conflicts with the Capabilities and Settings Class. Additional work remains and will be done in a future CR. The “big enumeration” is a candidate for deprecation.
- Reviewers should search for ‘[[’ in Ira’s document (~60 editor’s notes) which point out remaining issues to be checked.
- Ira will post an updated document this week. IANA textual conventions have been cleaned up. IPP attributes have also been cleaned up.
- Pointers to the printer MIB and IPP front matter will be provided in the WIMS CIM white paper. Diagrams will also be included from these documents.

- Bill reminded us of the decision of to have an alternating WIMS and SM teleconference on Wednesday mornings. The SM update activity has a long-term target (integration of counters, MFP model, etc.). RDF will be the mechanism to do the mapping.
- Ira also mentioned the proposal Ron made at the face-to-face meeting on adding MFP alerts to the Printer MIB. Bill will send Ron's minutes to PWG-Announce.
- CONSENSUS: No changes to the plan as presented to CIM Core are needed (especially for Phase I and II). A description of the general model is needed in the introductory text.

Next Steps / Open Actions:

- Ira will to post the revised white paper by the end of the week.
- Next teleconference is scheduled for 2/2/06.
